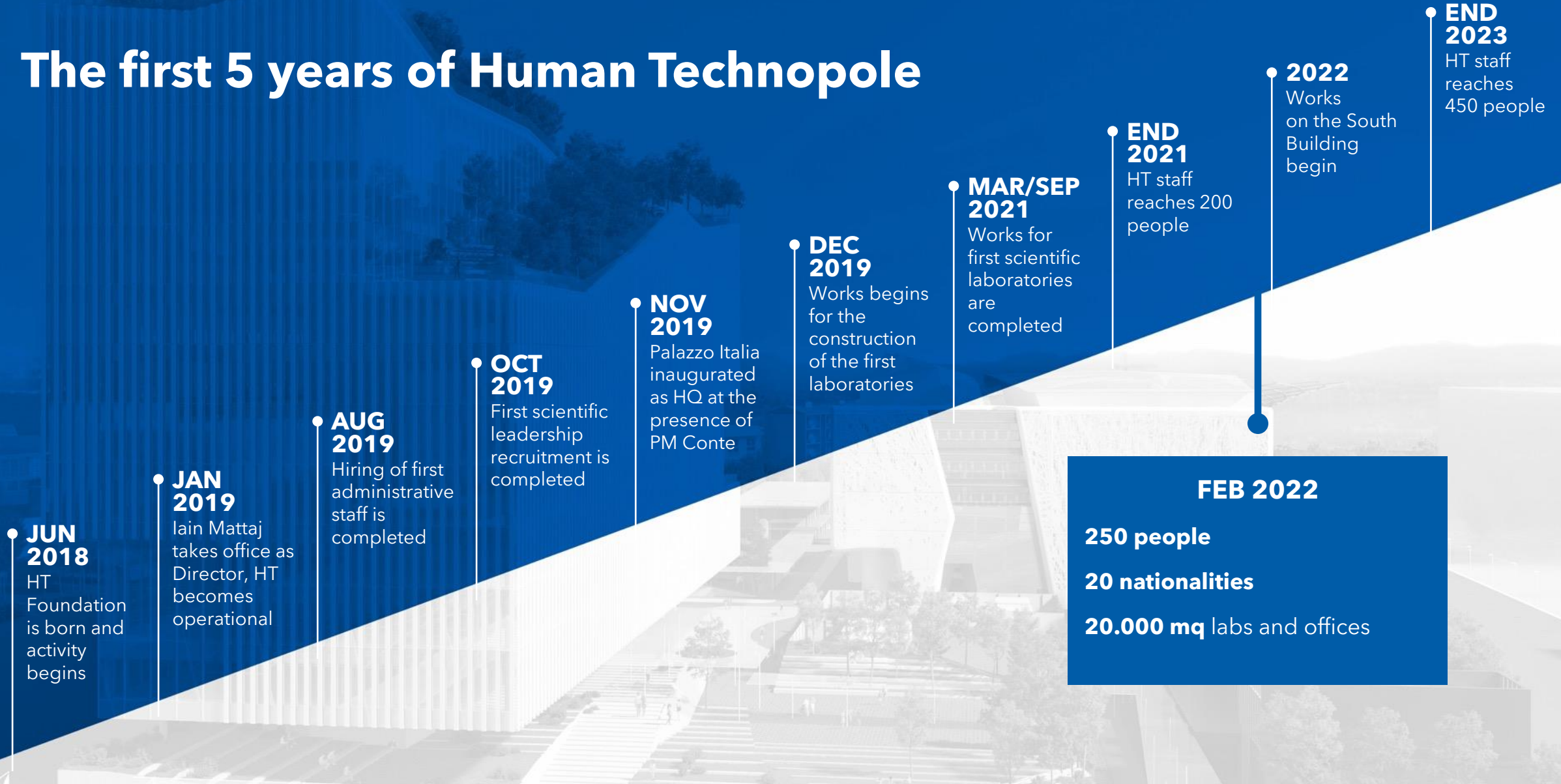
Carry out **frontier research to improve people's health and well-being**.

A new HT department for supporting LS innovation in Italy

According to Art. 49 of Law Decree no. 34 of 19th May 2020 (converted into law on 17th July 2020, no. 77), HT has established a **Centre for innovation and technology transfer (TT) in the field of Life Sciences**, as an internal department of the Foundation.

The department, established in July 2021, has the task to **promote innovative processes proposed by public and private entities in the research and innovation system**, focusing on:



IP MANAGEMENT

Support *patenting activity* and the *valorisation of intellectual property*



CENTRALISED NETWORK MANAGEMENT

Promote *collaboration among private entities of the innovation system* and *national and European research institutes*



DISSEMINATION OF RESEARCH RESULTS

Favor the *dissemination of research results* and the *transfer of knowledge*



STRATEGIC DEVELOPMENT

Encourage *research-driven collaborations between companies and innovative start-ups* for the development of *biotechnologies, artificial intelligence technologies for genetic, proteomic and metabolomic analyses, technologies for diagnostics, active surveillance, protection of fragile individuals, improvement of quality of life and active aging*
