

NOTICE TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA FOR CANDIDATES TO THE "4-DAYS FULL IMMERSION TRAINING ON TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER IN LIFE SCIENCES" PROGRAMME

Dear Candidate,

This is to inform you that, pursuant to Articles 12 and 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679 on the "Protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data" and subsequent modifications (hereinafter, "Regulations"), as part of the selection process initiated with the Human Technopole Foundation (HT) for admission to the "Cryo-EM Symposium", the latter handles a series of personal data relating to your person.

1. Identity and contact details of the Data Controller

The Data Controller of your personal data is the Human Technopole Foundation, with registered office in Viale Rita Levi-Montalcini 1, 20157, Milan (MI), Italy, Tel. +39/02-30247001, e-mail: gdpr@fht.org.

2. Contact details of the Data Protection Officer ("DPO")

3. Purposes and legal bases of the processing

The processing of your personal data by HT shall take place for the purpose of managing the selection process and the participation of candidates to the event called "Cryo-EM Symposium". In particular, your personal data will be processed for the following purposes

- a) Acquisition of data during the screening phase of applications for participation in the event;
- b) Evaluation of the suitability of the profile with respect to the content and training purposes of the event.
- c) Participation of selected candidates to the event

The legal basis of the processing for the purposes referred to in letters a) and b) of this notice is Article 6, letter b) of the Regulation: "*processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or for the performance of pre-contractual measures taken at the data subject's request*".

With reference to storage after the end of the selection, the legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(f), "*processing is necessary for the purposes of pursuing the legitimate interests of the controller or a third party*".

4. Nature of the data processed

As part of the process, HT may process the following categories of data relating to you:

- Common personal data such as, for example, name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number.

5. Method of processing

Your data will be processed by computer and on paper, observing the rules on the protection of personal data, including those relating to data security.

6. Categories of recipients of personal data

The data you provide may be disclosed to public and private entities relevant to the above purposes.

The communication of personal data is carried out on the basis of legal obligations.

Your data may also be processed by subjects appointed by HT as external data processors for purposes strictly related to the execution and management of the selection activities.

Moreover, it remains the obligation of HT to communicate the data to the Judicial Authority, every time a specific request in this regard is forwarded.

7. Data transfer outside the European Economic Area

In the event that your personal data should be processed in a country outside the European Economic Area (EEA), HT assures the adoption of appropriate precautions to guarantee that your personal data are adequately protected and in accordance with the levels of protection guaranteed by the EU regulations, applying one of the appropriate guarantees provided by the articles 44-50 of the Regulation.

8. Data retention

Your personal data will be stored in accordance with the security measures adopted by HT in the field of data protection, and access to it will be allowed only to the personnel involved and duly designated to process the data.

Your data will be kept for the time necessary for (and consistent with) the achievement of the purposes set forth in this Policy.

9. Rights of the data subject

You may at any time exercise the rights provided for in Article 13(b) and Articles 15, 16, 17, 18 and 20 of the Regulation by contacting the Data Controller at the contact points listed in point 1 of this notice.

In particular, as data subject, you may request:

1. access to your personal data, in accordance with Article 15 of the Regulation;
2. rectification of personal data concerning you, in accordance with Article 16 of the Regulation;
3. the deletion of personal data concerning him/her ("right to be forgotten"), as provided for in Article 17 of the Regulation
4. the restriction of the processing of personal data concerning him/her, in accordance with Article 18 of the Regulation.

Lastly, we inform you that you may object to the processing of your data at any time, pursuant to Article 21 of the Regulation, if one of the situations provided for in Article 6(1)(e) and (f) of the Regulation applies.

10. Consent and revocation

You may revoke your consent at any time by contacting the Data Controller.

11. Complaint to the Supervisory Authority

Finally, in accordance with Article 77 of the Regulation, we remind you that you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority (Garante per la Protezione dei dati personali) if you believe that the processing of your data violates the provisions of the Regulation.

12. Nature of the processing and obligatory nature of providing data

The data you are asked to provide are necessary for the selection activities and the participation of candidates to the event. Failure to provide them may result in the impossibility of carrying out these activities and exclusion from the selection process/event.

13. Existence of automated decision-making processes in the processing

It is specified that for the processing of the above-mentioned data there is NO type of automated decision-making process, pursuant to Article 22 of the Regulation.
